2017 Hot Wing Cook-Off Challenge RULES

Please read carefully & keep this copy. Rules are subject to change.

- Hot Wing Cook-Off Category & Additional Awards:** Best Traditional Hot Wings – Best Creative Wings –and People’s C ho ice Award. Trophies will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category. A **BIG TIPPER** Award will also be given for the booth that collects the most money for Crime Stoppers in their TIP Bucket (this will be provided at check in). **HINT:** You can start collecting or gathering donations NOW or IN ADVANCE and put them in your bucket that night! You can also donate online (See page 1.)
- Ingredients & Preparation** – Your team will be given 20 lbs. of naked wings generously donated by Popeye’s Famous Fried Chicken. If you would like to bread them you may do so but this is not required. Raw wings will be distributed at registration. You **MUST** have a way to keep them cold at your booth until they are cooked. A separate ice chest and ice is strongly recommended to store your chicken. ****This is a TRADITIONAL COOK-OFF and everything must be cooked ON-SITE. Judging begins at 5:30 PM and awards will be announced at 7:00 PM. Any seasoning or ingredient necessary to create unique taste is acceptable but **MUST be listed at your table (Example: Peanut Oil or a potential allergen).** Signage for levels of hotness **MUST also be listed at your table 1-10 scale, 10 being the hottest of the hot!!!** *******Electricity will NOT be provided on-site so please make sure you bring sterno’s for chaffing dishes, an ice chest, and/or whatever else you may need to serve them hot!**
- Cooking** - Teams **MUST** bring their own cooking equipment, pit, charcoal, tents, tables, chairs, serving utensils, storage equipment, serving plates, paper towels, and all other necessary serving items. This includes required signage (described above), table/booth decorations (optional), and whatever else you may need for your table & tent. Bring everything you will need. If you will need more than a 10X10 space please let us know in advance. **IMPORTANT: Please consider bringing additional wings! The public will be coming around to try your wings from 4 PM until 6:30PM. You will want to have enough wings to serve during the evening and reserve some of your wings for judging at 5:30, 6:00, and 6:30PM. The more wings the merrier!!! DO NOT serve to anyone who does not have a wristband on! Please send them to the registration tent to buy one if they need one. We will be happy to sell them one!**
- Selling** - Crime Stoppers of Tangipahoa will begin selling/registering the public for wristbands at 4 PM and will sell them until 7:00 PM. They will be allowed to vote until 7:00 PM, at which time the ballots will be collected. The cost for the public to buy a wristband is \$5.00. This price will include wings sampling and 1 ticket/ballot. Additional tickets/ballots can be purchased for \$1.00 apiece with a wrist band. The public will place their tickets/ballot in the individual ticket/ballot/TIP bucket at the booth of their choice. To be counted all tickets must be dropped in the ballot box no later than 6:30 PM. Beverages will be available for purchase separately at an additional cost. Each team will also receive a “Ticket/Ballot/TIP Bucket” to place at their booth. Each booth will need/want to encourage the public to drop the ticket/ballot in their “Ticket/Ballot Bucket” when tasting the wings. This is how you will win **People’s Choice (which is all about the number of tickets in your bucket at 6:30 PM)! You will also want to encourage people to TIP you by dropping TIPs or Donations in your TIP Bucket (you can start collecting donations now).** This is how you win the **Big Tipper Award!** NOTE: Public displays and demonstrations are encouraged in order to involve the crowd and fill up your Ticket/Ballot Bucket with their ticket/ballots and donations (within reason)!
- Judging** – Tickets/Ballots will determine the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners of the People’s Choice Award. The public will drop their Ticket/Ballot in the Ticket/Ballot/TIP Bucket of the booth of their choice to vote. **All ballots must be dropped in the ballot boxes no later than 6:30 PM. All Awards will begin at 7:00 PM.** A panel of judges will determine the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners of best Traditional Hot Wings and best Creative Wings. You will be given Judging Containers for each category:
 - Put **eight (8)** of your best Traditional Hot Wings and submit them to the Judging Coordinator at **5:30 PM** located at the Cook-off Check-in booth.
 - Put **eight (8)** of your best Creative Wings and submit them to the Judging Coordinator at **6:00 PM** located at the Cook-off Check-in booth.
 - Wings will be judged on the following: **Taste ----- Texture ----- Presentation.**
- On Site Check In & Registration** – Teams **MUST Pre-Register by Friday, October 20, 2017 in order to participate.** Upon arrival at the cooking site, **Memorial Park, 301 N. 6th St., Ponchatoula,** the team captain must check in at the Cook-Off Sign In table for team number and booth space assignment. **On Cook-off Day, Oct. 28th, the Cook-Off Sign In & Registration table will be open at NOON at which time (if pre-registered) you may complete your onsite registration and set up your booth.** You will also pick up raw wings at this time. Please like our Facebook page, www.facebook.com/tangicrimestoppers for the most up to date Cook- Off and Night Out Information.
- Booth Set-up - Booth Set up and Team Sign In will be allowed from NOON until 3:00 PM.** Visit the Cook-Off Sign In Tent upon arrival. Bring everything that you will need to serve your wings (plates, napkins, etc.) and for your booth. We will not provide anything except the chicken wings. Public displays and demonstrations are encouraged in order to involve the crowd and fill up your Ticket/Ballot Bucket with their ticket/ballots and donations (within reason)!
- Booth Teardown** – Booth teardown will not be permitted until after the awards ceremony. At that time everything must be removed from the site by 8:00 PM. Please remember to pick up your trash and place it in a trash can.
- Fees** – There is **NO** Entry Fee! Donations are graciously accepted and can be made payable to **CRIME STOPPERS OF TANGIPAOHA, INC. but are not required.** All donations are non-refundable and can be made on line at www.tangicrimestoppers.com/events under the Hot Wing Cook-off information or turned in in person the night of the event! **HINT: The team with the most TIPS/Donations in their ticket/ballot/TIP bucket wins the Big Tipper Award!** Proceeds benefit Crime Stoppers of Tangipahoa, Inc. a 501c3 non-profit organization & United Way of Southeast Louisiana Community Partner agency.
