2014 Hot Wing Cook-Off Challenge RULES

Please read carefully & keep this copy. Rules are subject to change.

- Hot Wing Cook-Off Category & Additional Awards:** People's Choice Award and Big Tipper Award - A Trophy will be given for each Category. If you would like to decorate your booth (not required) you will be entered into Best Decorated Booth Contest for a prize!
- Ingredients & Preparation** – Your team will be given 10 lbs. of naked wings generously donated by our sponsor. If you would like to bread them you may do so but this is not required. **Raw wings will be distributed at 5:00 PM. You MUST have a way to keep them cold at your booth until they are cooked. A separate ice chest and ice is strongly recommended to store your chicken.** Each team will cook all **10lbs.** of wings for the competition. ******This is a TRADITIONAL COOK-OFF and everything must be cooked ON-SITE after distribution of the Chicken. Public judging begins at 6:45 PM and will go until 8:30 PM. Awards will be announced at 9:00 PM. Any seasoning or ingredient necessary to create unique taste is acceptable but MUST be listed at your table (Example: Peanut Oil or a potential allergen). Signage for levels of hotness MUST also be listed at your table 1-10 scale, 10 being the hottest of the hot!!! *****Electricity will NOT be provided on-site so please make sure you bring sterno's for chaffing dishes, an ice chest, and/or whatever else you may need to serve them hot!**
- Cooking** - Teams MUST bring their own cooking equipment, pit, charcoal, tents, tables, chairs, serving utensils, storage equipment, serving plates, paper towels, and all other necessary serving items. This includes required signage (described above), table/booth decorations (optional), and whatever else you may need for your table & tent. Bring everything you will need.
- Selling & Tip Jars** - Crime Stoppers of Tangipahoa will begin selling/registering the public for wristbands at **1:00 PM and will sell them until 8:30 PM. The public will not be able to sample your wings and begin voting until for a winner until 6:45 PM. They will be allowed to vote until 8:45 PM, at which time the ballots will be collected.** All proceeds from the sale of the wristbands will be benefit Crime Stoppers of Tangipahoa's Community Crime Prevention Programs and does NOT go toward the paying of rewards. **The cost for the public to buy a wristband is \$5.00 This price will includes wings sampling, two (2) sides from Santa Fe Cattle Co., and 5 tickets/ballots. Additional tickets/ballots can be purchased for \$1.00 apiece with a wrist band. The public will write the number of their favorite team on the back of their tickets and will drop them in the Ballot Box at the Cook-Off Registration Table. To be counted all tickets must be dropped in the ballot box no later than 8:45 PM.** Beverages will be available for purchase separately at an additional cost. Each team will also receive a "Tip Jar/Bucket" to place at their booth. Each booth will need/want to encourage the public to drop money in their jar when tasting the wings. Be Creative (within reason)! The team that raises the most money in their jar will win a special "Big Tipper" prize. You may also decorate your booth (not required). This will make you eligible for the Best Decorated/Theme Booth Prize!
- Judging** – Tickets/Ballots will determine the winner of the People's Choice Award. The wristbands to sample the wings and judge will be available for purchase at the cook-off registration tent for \$5.00. Additional Tickets may be purchased for \$1.00 each with a wristband. The public will write the team number of their favorite wings on the back of their tickets and drop them in the ballot box to vote. **All ballots must be dropped in the ballot box at the cook-off registration tent no later than 8:45 PM.** No late tickets will be accepted. Winners will be announced at 9:00PM. The Big Tipper Award will be determined by the team that raises the most money in their Tip Jar/Bucket! The Best Decorated Booth Winners will be determined by the Night Out Committee.
- Prizes** - Prizes are non-transferable nor redeemable for cash.
- On Site Check In & Registration** – Teams **MUST Pre-Register by Monday, September 22, 2014 in order to participate.** Upon arrival at the cooking site (210 NE Central Ave, Amite, LA 70422), the team captain must check in at the Cook-Off Sign In table for team number and booth space assignment. **The Cook-Off Sign In & Registration table will be open at 1:00 PM at which time (if pre-registered) you may complete your onsite registration and set up your booth.** Please like our Facebook page www.facebook.com/tangicrimestoppers for the most up to date Cook-Off and Night Out Information.
- Booth Set-up** - **Booth Set up and Team Sign In will be allowed from 1:00 PM until 4:30 PM.** Visit the Cook-Off Sign In Tent upon arrival. Bring everything that you will need to serve your wings (plates, napkins, etc.) and for your booth. We will not provide anything except the chicken wings. Public displays and demonstrations are encouraged in order to involve the crowd and fill up your "Tip Jar" with the most money!
- Booth Teardown** – Booth teardown will not be permitted until after the awards ceremony. At that time everything must be removed from the site by 10:00 PM. Please remember to pick up your trash and place it in a trash can.
- Fees** – There is no Entry Fee! Donations are graciously accepted and can be made payable to **CRIME STOPPERS OF TANGIPAHOA, INC. but are not required.** All donations are non-refundable and can be made on line at www.tangicrimestoppers.com/events under the Hot Wing Cook-off information.
